Rt. 81 South:

Follow 81S to exit #21 (Enola) for Rt. 11/15 South. Follow 11/15 South through Harrisburg to Gettysburg. There are 6 Gettysburg exits. Take the 6th exit (Steinwehr Ave). Turn right at the top of the ramp. The Conference Center is just over 2 miles on the right.

Rt. 15 North:

Follow 15 North through Frederick and past the PA state line. Take the first exit in PA (Steinwehr Ave). Turn left at the top of the ramp. The Conference Center is just over 2 miles on the right.

Rt. 76 East and West:

Follow PA Turnpike to exit #17 (Gettysburg).
Follow Rt. 15 South and precede with the directions above for “Rt. 81 South.”
